People may substitute knowledge for action, leading to a superficial understanding and reduced civic engagement.

KEY CHARACTERISTICS

- Illusion of A _____: People may feel informed but fail to take meaningful action.
- A _____: Continuous exposure to news can lead to emotional numbness, especially regarding negative events.
- S _____ Concern: The vast amount of information can create only a fleeting concern for societal issues, rather than prompting involvement
